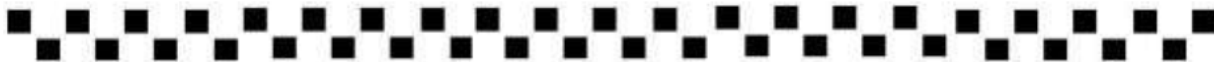


# NERC Grand Prix 2011



The Grand Prix Race Series, a friendly competition among NERC members, features a number of changes this year. The series has been expanded: we have added two (2) additional races this year: the Friday Night Lights Race in July and the Painesville Turkey Trot in November. ## Grand Prix 2011 Rules

1. Any NERC member who participates in a Grand Prix race is eligible and will be scored. There is no additional fee. You still have to register and pay for each individual race you run.
2. There are seventeen (17) Grand Prix Races in 2011. Your best eight (8) race finishes will be used to determine your final results. You can run fewer races and still accumulate enough points to place. However, you must run at least five (5) Grand Prix races to be eligible for an award.
3. Your age as of the first Grand Prix Race will determine your age group for the year. Age groups for male and female runners are: 19& under, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, and 60 & over.
4. You must be a member of NERC the day before each GP race to be scored. If you have not renewed, please do so today.

6. Results will be posted on the NERC website. The results will be updated as promptly as possible.

## Grand Prix 2011 Scoring

1. Overall: The top male & female members will be scored 100 pts for 1st, 90 pts for 2nd, 80 pts for 3rd and so on down to 10 points for 10th.
2. Age Groups: The top male and female members will be scored using the same format 100 points down to 10 points for the first 10 finishers in each age group.
